Services Provided at Bridges to Safety

- Crisis intervention, personal advocacy and legal advocacy
- Legal consultation and representation provided by Southern MN Regional Legal Services and Tubman
- Law enforcement investigation and prosecution of offenders
- Order for Protection writing/filing
- Supervised play for children while the parent/guardian is accessing services
- Access to safe child visitation services
- Referral to shelter, permanent and transitional housing, employment, personal counseling, and other community partners.

About Domestic Violence

Domestic violence is defined as a pattern of behavior in any relationship that is used to gain or maintain power and control over an intimate partner. Abuse is physical, sexual, emotional, economic or psychological actions or threats that influence, hurt or control another person.
